# Technical Rider Bal des Oiseaux

Up to date 11th of october 2024 This technical rider is an integral part of the contract.

All elements of this technical rider are entirely at the organizer's expense (unless otherwise specified).

Technical aspects may be adapted to suit the performance venue, subject to prior agreement with the stage manager. All information concerning the performance venue must be discussed with the stage manager prior to his arrival, in order to ensure optimum Please send us photos of the chosen venue beforehand.

Be sure to consult the latest version of the technical rider.

**Duration: 3h15** 

Capacity: 400 if small layout; 800 if comfort layout.

Open space and continuous circulation. If there is a large audience, it allows the outsiders to enjoy the show

#### Implantation:

Minimum surface 25 x 30 m (even and flat)

Ideal surface: 30 x 35 m (even and flat)

Minimum height: indoor 6 m for the central mast, 4 m outdoor

#### Weather conditions and indoor fallback:

Le Bal des Oiseaux is designed to be performed outdoors, but if the weather conditions are such that the wind exceeds 50km/h and/or if there is more than 3mm of rain during the show, the performance will be canceled in accordance with the terms of the contract.

An indoor set-up can be considered in advance if it has been validated by our stage manager and if the decision to move in is taken on D-2 at the latest.






# **GROUND PLANE**



## **RIDER**

#### **Dressing rooms:**

Close to the venue (easily and quickly accessible on foot), the artists will need

a large, clean, heated dressing room that is out of sight and can be locked or guarded/monitored and equipped with a table and chairs, mirrors, racks with hangers, selective waste, electrical sockets and toilets nearby. There should be showers and towels provided for the artists after the performance.

In the event of several performances during the day or several successive days of play, a washing machine must be provided (with detergent), tumble dryer and iron (with ironing board).

#### Catering:

Please provide a water point for filling water bottles, snacks with small cakes and honey, fruit, cold drinks (fruit juices, soft drinks, local craft beers if possible) and hot drinks.

Hot drinks - 100% Arabica coffee (no red coffee). If possible, please prefer fair-trade and organic coffee and tea.

#### Meals:

If the meals are included in the contract, please provide 12 to 13 hot meals in the dressing rooms 2 hours before the show, with a balanced diet that respects our dietary requirements. Please provide a microwave to heat them up.

#### **Accommodation:**

If accommodation is provided for in the contract, please book 1 double room and 11 single rooms. No twin rooms. Depending on the availability of accommodation in the surrounding area, the team may accept to stay in a guest house.

The accommodation must be close to the venue (accessible in less than 10 minutes by foot). The vehicles are to remain on the guarded site, so bikes (better) or transportation will be needed if the accommodation is further away.

We don't ask for more than what we need to make sure we have enough.

We can always adapt to specific conditions, but all we ask is
to be informed in advance so that we can work out solutions together. Thank you for never

presenting us with a 'fait accompli' on the day of the show.

Please do not hesitate to contact us as soon as possible if you encounter any problems.
